Search tips from the "Google" and not "Google" team to help you get the most out of your search.

Here are some of the best ways of maximizing your Google search... like a boss!

- use** **Question Marks**
Use question marks for an exact answer or set of results. You'll only see results that include the words and using them. **"To be or not to be"**
- use** **Dashes**
Put a dash before a word that you want to exclude in your search. **jaguar -animal**
- use** **Title**
Use a title before a term to restrict results and to highlight. **Christmas -desserts**
- use** **site:query**
Use site to search within a specific website. **site:nytimes.com**
- use** **link:query**
Use link to search for sites that link to the specified site or URL. **link:crafts.com**
- use** **Year Periods**
Use year periods to restrict the number of results to a specific range of things that were manufactured in a specific year. **movies 1960..1970**
- use** **related:query**
Use related to find sites that are related to the specified site. **related:apple.com**
