An already established and celebrated artist, Marilyn Minter's show at the Contemporary Arts Center features the hyper-realistic recent paintings and photographs reveal the thoughtful dialogue work for which she is so well known, in thoughtful dialogue with the more abstract work she creates. Saturated, slick and enamel paintings and lush color photographs reveal the sometimes flawed side of glamour. Included in the glossy, her work focuses sharply on a detail or moment of imperfection. It is the combination of technique, perspective, use of color and finishes, which provides such a fresh take on the topic of female beauty and empowerment. Included in the tour is the museum debut of Green Pink Caviar, the video that gained fame playing on the MTV HD billboard in Times Square and accompanying Madonna on her 2009 European tour. For the video, Minter directed her models to lick brightly colored candy on a sheet of glass and then shot them from underneath.

Minter was born in 1948 in Shreveport, Louisiana, but lives and works in New York. She received her Bachelor of Fine Arts from the University of Florida in 1970 and a Master of Fine Art from Syracuse University in 1972. Recent exhibitions include the 2006 Whitney Biennial, SITE Santa Fe, Fotomuseum Winterthur, and a solo exhibition at San Francisco Museum of Modern Art.
